# AIM OF THE VISIT

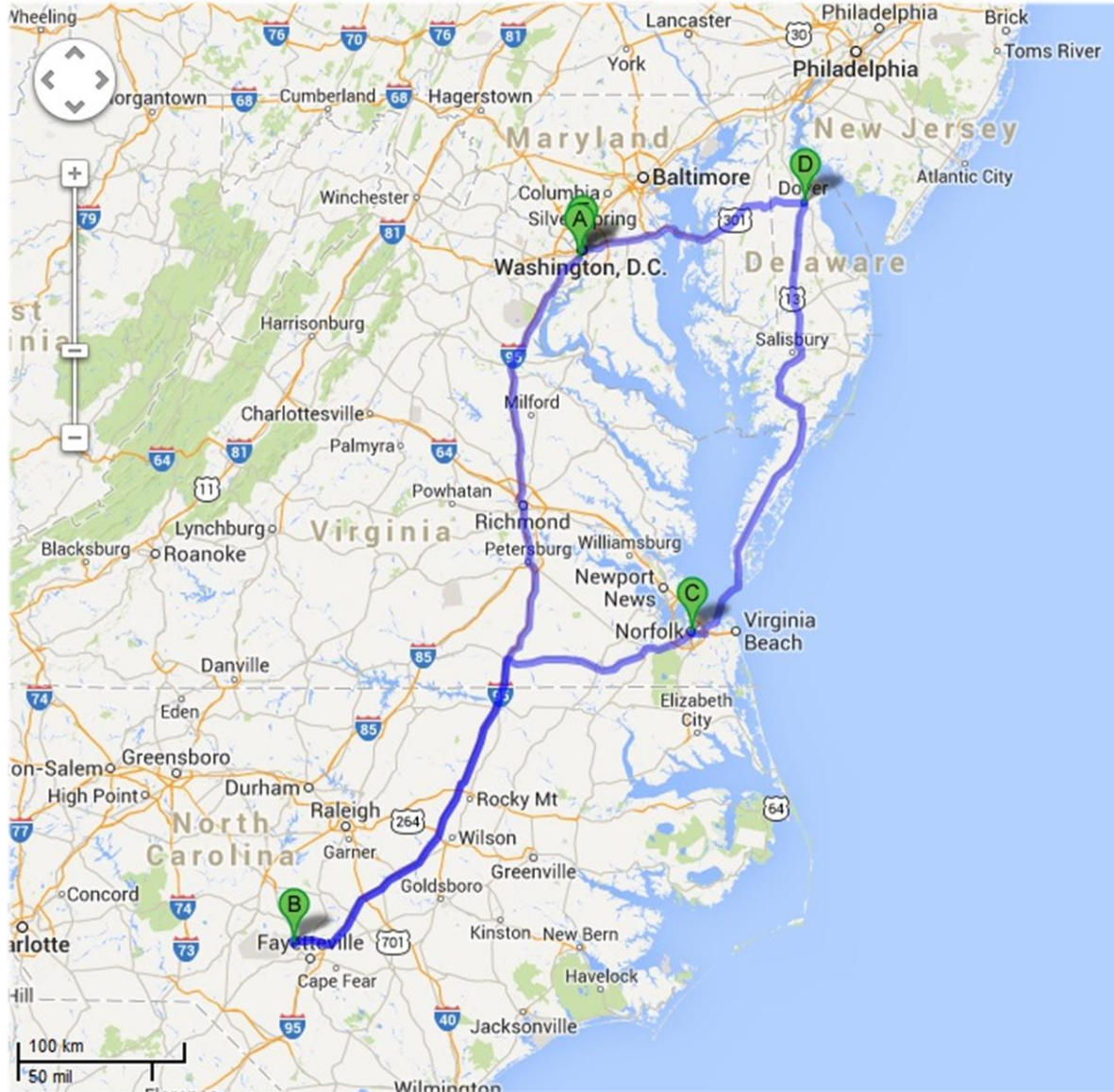
- Get an understanding of the energy challenges the US defense faces, with regards to both operational as well as facilities energy
